From the Pastor's Pen...

The POWER of ONE

"That night Paul had a vision: A man from Macedonia in northern Greece was standing there, pleading with him, "Come over to Macedonia and help us!" (Acts 16:9 NLT)

The Apostle Paul saw ONE man in a vision. When Paul arrived in Philippi, ONE woman named Lydia responded to the gospel and invited Paul into her home (Acts 16:14-15). Paul cast a demon out of ONE slave girl (Acts 16:16-18). In jail, Paul led ONE jailer to saving faith in Jesus Christ (Acts 16:29-34). As a result of each of these "ONE", families were saved, a city was moved, and a church was established that continued to support Paul on missionary journeys (Philippians 4:15-19). All because of ONE!

With God, Every ONE Matters! Who is that ONE person that you know that needs Christ in their life? It may be a family member that grew up in church but has strayed away. It may be that neighbor next door or down the street. It may be that co-worker on your job. It may even be that "friend" on Social Media.
