**The Rachel Michelle Malone Memorial Scholarship**  
Sponsored by Michael & Georgia Malone

The Rachel Michelle Malone Memorial Scholarship has been established through Brown Missionary Baptist Church (BMBC) by Michael and Georgia Malone to honor the memory of their daughter, Rachel Michelle, whose life, although very short, served a great purpose.

The intent of the scholarship is to financially assist students each year who are active members of BMBC who plan to attend a Historically Black College/University (HBCU). There will be **FOUR** scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 (\$500/semester.) The following guidelines will be required in order for funds to be administered.

Applicants will be required to submit a 300–450 word essay on: *How I plan to incorporate community service in my career choice?*

Eligibility:

- The student must have achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of a 2.5 and be in good standing.
- The student must be an active member of BMBC for at least six months.
- The student must be a graduating senior.
- An unofficial copy of your high school transcript.
- A copy of your college acceptance letter.
- The student plans to attend a HBCU.
- Prior to scholarship funds being granted, the Student Enrollment Verification must be submitted.

Scholarship recipients are required to have 6 hours of community service at BMBC or an approved offsite location. The work form is to be submitted along with your application. Volunteer hours must be approved by BMBC.

Scholarship monies will be awarded directly to the school upon receipt of Student Enrollment Verification document. Students should not depend on scholarship funds for initial registration/tuition fees.

All eligible students may apply by completing an application. Incomplete or late applications will not be processed. An official letter from the BMBC Education Ministry will notify student awarded scholarships.
