READ

As you prepare to read, first take a moment and prepare your heart and focus your mind with a simple prayer. "Lord, lead me in Your truth and teach me . . ." Psalm 25:5a Write out word for word the Key Verse of the passage in which God spoke to you (include the scripture reference)

EXAMINE

What is the context, who is talking, who are they talking to, what issue is being addressed, etc.? Ask the basic questions of who, what, where, when, why and how. Then finally, what did I learn? In a few sentences write out the Key Thought of the passage or how God spoke to you the most.

APPLY

How does this apply to my life?

How do I need to live?

In one or two sentences write out a Key Application:

What you will do differently in your life because of the passage?

Write out how you are going to take action with what God has shown you.

PRAY

You should view your time in the Word as a conversation, not a monologue. God speaks to you through His Word, but as in any conversation, deeper understanding and levels of communication occur in the context of a back and forth dialogue. Write in a few sentences a prayer to God. Pray that during the day through the power of the Holy Spirit, you will apply these principles from God's Word to your life.
