World Relief Memphis has been the sole refugee resettlement agency in Memphis since 2012. As the only Evangelical Christian resettlement agency nationally, they serve refugees and immigrants from around the world by providing services such as refugee resettlement, employment aid, and legal assistance

BMBC's financial support will allow World Relief to accomplish the following:

- **Provide bus fare for a newly employed refugee to/from work for one week**
- **Buy school uniforms, shoes and supplies for refugee children**
- **Provide rent and utilities for a recently settled families of 5 or more**
- **Help educate, equip and empower churches and the community to be more welcoming to the vulnerable and provide immigration legal services to our clients**

CARE CENTER



Care Center

The Care Center seeks to assist women with free pregnancy care and resources. They also provide adoption referrals, conduct phone-counseling sessions, and plant countless seeds in the hearts and minds of their clients about God's love for them. To date the Care Center has been able to provide services to over 40,000 women.

BMBC's financial support will allow the Care Center to accomplish the following:

- **Provide diapers, wipes, baby wash, and infant clothing for newborns**
- **Provide prenatal vitamins for women**
- **Replace very old, very worn flooring and/or bath fixtures**
- **Provide full time medical staff members for the Care Center**

YOUTH VILLAGES



Youth VILLAGES

Youth Villages is a private nonprofit organization dedicated to helping emotionally and behaviorally troubled children and their families live successfully.

BMBC's financial support will allow Youth Villages to accomplish the following:

- **Provide bibles or copies of My Heart Christ's Home discipleship book for kids**
- **Provide a special lunch (Christmas, Thanksgiving, Easter) for each facility**
- **Provide the annual salary for 1 part-time intern in the Spiritual Life Program**
- **Provide one year's salary for 3 assistant coordinators who are desperately needed to facilitate the demanding and ongoing needs of the Spiritual Life Program**

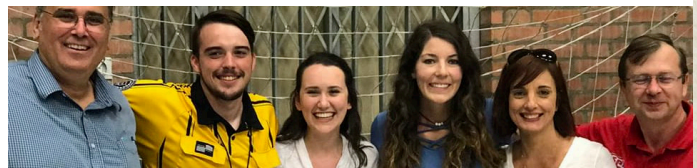
BMBC's financial support will allow Grace Baptist Church to accomplish the following:

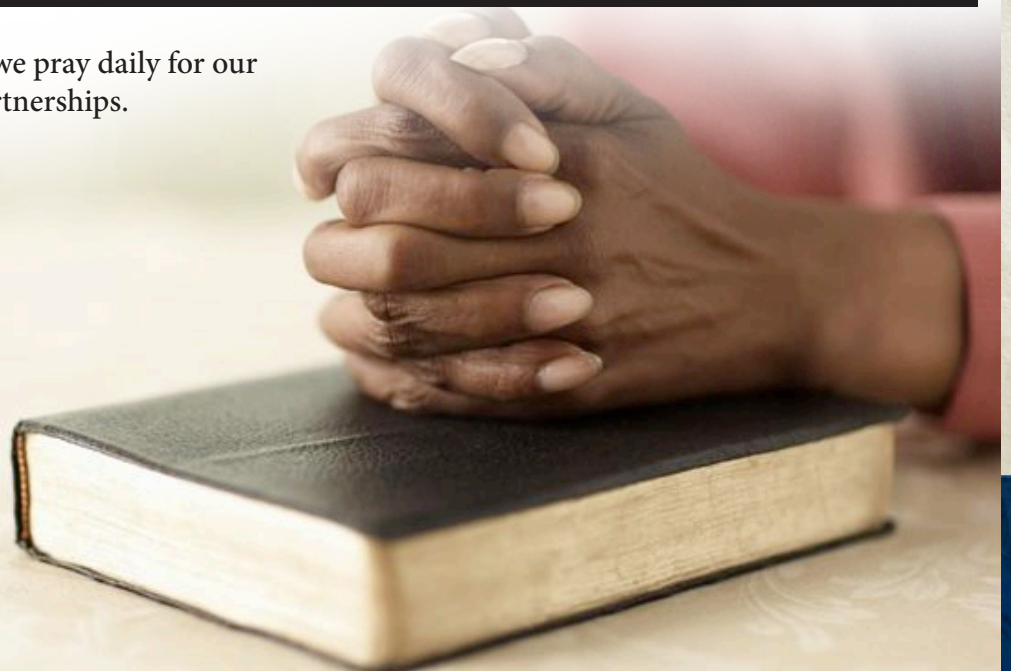

Service Opportunity #1: Georgian Hills School Partnership

BMBC has adopted Georgian Hills Elementary School. Volunteers assist children with homework and tutoring after school as well as mentor & work with students on attendance, academics and behavior. Training and ongoing support is provided by the Agape staff.

MEMPHIS UNION MISSION



Memphis Union Mission ministers to the physical, spiritual and emotional needs of men, women and families who are homeless, addicted, and in crisis.

Brown Baptist volunteers serve meals and conduct worship services at the Union Mission to share the love of Christ. Opportunities for volunteers of all ages are available throughout the year.

KIDS BEACH CLUB



KiDs Beach Club® (KBC) is an innovative ministry that provides a Jesus Experience to students within the culture of his or her public elementary school.

BMBC volunteers mentor and teach children the character traits of Jesus Christ during the school semesters. Volunteers are needed to work with 3rd-6th graders at Southaven Intermediate School every week.

CALVARY RESCUE MISSION



Calvary Rescue Mission is a non-profit, independent, faith-based shelter for homeless men in Memphis, TN. Calvary serves two full meals a day, offers clothing to the homeless, has a 2500 volume library, and provides nightly chapel services, counseling, a discipleship program, and lodging. The mission has continued for over 43 years strictly from donations from churches and Christian friends. Calvary Rescue Mission is a totally independent (dependent on God of course) not for profit charitable organization that accepts no government money. Through the years it has pleased God to continue to operate the mission in this manner.

Several times throughout the year, Brown provides meals at the shelter. You can provide your gift of music or speech to help inspire the gentlemen at the shelter during a nightly meal.

MIFA (METROPOLITAN INTER-FAITH ASSOCIATION)



MIFA (Metropolitan Inter-Faith Association) was founded in 1968 in an unprecedented cooperative effort uniting church and community leaders to confront the growing issues of poverty, hunger, and social division in Memphis. Created in the wake of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s assassination, MIFA began as a volunteer-driven advocacy agency and has since evolved into a broad-based, professional, nonprofit social service organization with a focused mission: MIFA supports the independence of vulnerable seniors and families in crisis through high-impact programs. Its vision is to unite the community through service.

Deliver a hot meal and a warm smile to homebound seniors weekday mornings. Saturday routes are also available on a limited basis. Volunteers arrive at MIFA between 9 and 10 a.m. to retrieve meals, driving directions, as well as two coolers for food storage. Delivering one route typically takes less than two hours.



RISE AGAINST HUNGER



Rise Against Hunger is an international hunger relief organization that distributes food and life-changing aid to the world's most vulnerable, mobilizing the necessary resources to end hunger by 2030. BMBC partners with Rise Against Hunger each June to host on-site food packaging events in the Family Enrichment Center. Volunteers are needed to help package healthy meals.

To date, BMBC volunteers have helped package over 56,000 meals that have been shipped to countries such as Honduras and Haiti.
